The Summit Lock and new LowPro Summit Lock are the original proximal lock mechanisms, and the only zero clearance locks. This makes them the ideal lock for long limb types that do not have clearance for a traditional pin system or lanyard.



New liner attachment makes it easier for the patient to roll the liner on, and adheres to the liner better. It is also lower in profile for a more comfortable fit and better adhesion to the liner.

LowPro lock is mounted from the inside for easier engagement. Lower profile also makes it easier to cover cosmetically.

The tab's multiple tooth design, similar to a lock pin, offers no-fuss adjustment throughout the day, and can be loosened for more comfort while seated.

New tab design offers easier engagement.

Nothing is mounted distally; you don't even need to buy a locking liner.

The Summit Lock's patented mounting method of attaching to the liner and the socket wall was the first of its kind to control rotation.

All parts for fabrication, except adhesive, are now included.
