WHO Heel/Forefoot Indications

- As a stage two device when daytime ambulation is desired
- Used in conjunction with the ADO night time orthosis
- Used as a post-operative walking orthosis
- Post TAL Procedure
- Wagner 1-3 wounds where un-weighted ambulation is desired

ADO Indications

- Wagner 1+ ulceration of the heel. (Can be constructed to accommodate malleolus and forefoot wounds.)
- Post-operative wound care. ADO easily accommodates a Wound VAC
- Post-Calcanectomy

WHO Mid-foot/Walking Indications

- Relief for midfoot ulcer during ambulation
- Post-TAL with plantar ulcer
- Immediate post-op forefoot or midfoot amputation
- Immediate post Symes amputation
- Post Charcot support and Rocker Foot support
- Post-Calcanectomy
