Ultraflex Adjustable Dynamic Response™ (ADR™) AFOs are being used bilaterally to assist and resist dorsflexion and plantarflexion, to position the foot for heel strike, to smooth weight acceptance, and to allow Drake to advance his tibia forward over his foot during ambulation. ADR™ allows greater range, augments muscle weakness, reduces fatigue, and increases stability. The ADR™ component channels are compressed for resistance or dampening effects, making the orthoses adjustable while worn and customizable to Drake's presentation. ADR™ components come with a limited lifetime warranty. As Drake experiences physiological changes, his ADR™ components will continue to meet his orthotic needs.
