

Prior to Ultraflex bracing, Ivan wore solid AFOs and then SMOs to address instability secondary to diplegic spastic CP. Ivan's therapist noted that "The solid AFOs were too restrictive and the SMOs alone never gave him enough support." Falls were frequent especially when walking on uneven surfaces. A year and a half ago, Ivan was fitted with bilateral Ultraflex Adjustable Dynamic Response[™] (ADR[™]) AFOs with SMOs. ADR[™] braces provide a solid base of support without restricting ankle motion (0-40° DF, 0-40° PF resistance or dampening effects). Now Ivan's physical therapist reports, "With ADR™, Ivan can walk all the way around the outside of the clinic without falling due to the motion allowed with the ADR[™] braces."
